

## Letter of Agreement

Zurich, 15<sup>th</sup> March 2018

### EAACI National Allergy Society Dual Membership

The purpose of this document is to conclude the mutually agreed EAACI National Allergy Society (NAS) Dual Membership. This applies to national society members of the EAACI National Societies Committee.

With this letter of agreement EAACI and the **Czech Society of Allergology and Clinical Immunology, Czech Medical Association of J. E. Purkyne, Sokolska 490/31, 120 00 Praha 2, Czech Republic**, named hereafter as "Society", represented by their president **Petr Panzner** agree on the terms of dual membership as defined below.

The EAACI NAS Dual Membership will be available to all current members of a respective national society who are in good standing. These individuals are entitled to a fee of **30 EUR for the annual EAACI membership**.

#### This type of membership entitles the following benefits:

1. Online subscription to Allergy and PAI. The applicant can opt-in for a print copy for the same price as EAACI Junior members (current price is 60 EUR/year for both journals, Allergy and PAI)
2. Online subscription to the EAACI Newsletter
3. Membership rate on registration fees to EAACI Focused Meetings, Allergy Schools and the EAACI/UEMS Knowledge Exam (Not valid for the registration of the EAACI Annual Congress).
4. Online access to all EAACI Resources (guidelines, educational materials, etc.)
5. Possibility to join EAACI Sections, Interest Groups, Working Groups and Task Forces
6. Voting rights
7. EAACI Member Certificate

#### The following conditions must be duly obeyed:

1. Payment of the membership fees shall be invoiced separately to both contracting parties. EAACI and the NAS Society shall receive the membership fee from each member directly.
2. The application for the dual membership will be submitted by the individual via the online EAACI membership form available on the EAACI website.
3. On starting the dual membership agreement the "Society" will provide EAACI with a confirmation-check email address.

4. Once a membership request has been received by EAACI, the “Society” will receive an email to their confirmation-check email address. The email will include a special link that directs to an online webpage, where NAS will be able to confirm if the member is in a good standing for that calendar year or not (ergo: approve or reject application). EAACI will be automatically informed about this action and the application will be processed accordingly.
5. The “Society” holds the responsibility for the accuracy of the data provided.
6. It is mandatory for the “Society” to unsolicited send yearly updates (end of Oct of each year) about the individual being in good or not good standing to EAACI. Furthermore, the “Society” has to report if there are any changes in the membership status of the individual. If there is no update from the society, the Dual NAS Membership will be switched to a normal membership.
7. The “Society” will advertise the dual membership to its members yearly via the following channels:
  - a. Ongoing advertisement on their website.
  - b. Two emails to their members per year.
  - c. At their annual main society event/congress.

The dual membership agreement cannot be combined with other categories of membership such as Junior and or other dual (international) memberships that may exist with other international societies.

### **Term and termination**

This agreement starts with the date of the contract signature [date agreed] and will remain in effect for two (2) calendar years (hereinafter called the “term of agreement”). Thereafter, the term of agreement shall be renewed by mutual consent on the same terms and conditions herein for an additional one (1) year unless notification of the intention to terminate this agreement is given in writing by either party giving 1 months’ notice.

EAACI can terminate this agreement immediately by giving a written notice to the “Society” if:

1. The “Society” is in breach of a material provision of this agreement and does not remedy such breach within 30 days after the receipt of a written notice from EAACI to this effect.
2. If the “Society” commits an act or an omission (not necessarily related to this contract) which jeopardises or damages EAACI’s reputation seriously and which in EAACI’s reasonable judgment cannot be remedied anymore.


### **General Provision**

1. This agreement shall be construed in accordance with, and shall be governed in all respects by, the laws of Switzerland. All disputes arising out of or in connection with the present agreement shall be finally settled by the competent courts of Zurich, Switzerland.
2. Any amendment and supplement to this agreement shall require a written form to be effective. A waiver of this written form requirement must also be given in writing.

3. If any provision of this agreement shall be declared invalid, unenforceable or illegal, such invalidity, unenforceability or illegality shall not prejudice or affect the validity, enforceability and legality of the remaining provisions of this agreement.
4. During the term of this agreement the "Society" shall be considered as independent and shall not be considered as partner or agent of EAACI. As such, neither party shall have the authority to create or assume any obligation in the name of the other party or to bind the other in any manner whatsoever. Both parties will refrain from all actions or omissions which could mislead the public as to the relationship between the parties.
